Graffiti Wall

"It provides an open canvas on which participants can freely offer their written or visual comments about an environment or system directly in the context of use."

The method encourages participants through natural means of facility, casual, anonymous remarks about an environmental space, system or facility."

User Journey Map

"Is a visualization of the experiences people have when interacting with a product or service, so that each moment can be individually evaluated and improved."

This map tells you a story about an individual's actions, feelings, perceptions and frame of mind, including positive, negative and neutral moments."

Why is it useful?
Helps us understand HUMAN BEHAVIOR

Why is it useful?
Very open tool to approach people in a non-invasive way and has the potential of in-depth responses.

User Journey Map




- (-) Round #1**
1. We shouldn't have had that many questions for the effectiveness of the graffiti wall (considering that not so many answered)
 2. On a place with high visual information (on field) it's hard to get people's attention.
 3. Need a bigger pool of answers to get a better view of the people's interaction with the place
- (+) Round #2**
1. Round #2 helped us observe and talk to people to have more insights about their perception of the place / emotion approach
 2. The UJM helped us in this case to get a better appreciation of our location (while the graffiti wall method)

Our theory was that if people used Instagram it would be more personal for them, and allow them an open place to answer the questions.



Be careful with abrupt transitions "how is it participating in your community" vs "where is your nearest voting center."

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



INSIGHTS ON PROCESS
POSITIVE ASPECTS OF THE WORKSHOP

We felt students were engaged.

The activity encouraged group participation.

The activity left space for people to express themselves openly.

POSITIVE ASPECTS OF THE WORKSHOP

Meditation introduction was a good start for engagement with the activity.

Good collaboration with the teacher.

Planning time frame is important to make the activity work better.

Having thought multiple options of creative activities in case lack of inspiration.

Having planned in advance the roles of each teammate.

INSIGHTS ON PROCESS
AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

More time than 50 min would have been ideal.

Manage how to set (low) expectations on creativity processes (to reduce pressure and inhibition to creative thinking).

Some students came late so they missed the introduction and context (and it was more difficult for them to enter the activity).

Be aware and solve for different personality types more effectively.

Some students may need different instructions for the assignment.

We have to frame the activity limited on the classroom context.



Schematic of Voter Directions



Intervention Design

Setting: Union Square with "walls"/ invitation on chalkboard.

Corner: Space to sit and talk.

Invitation: People (over +18 years old) approach us to enter and sit.

Session: 10-15 minutes

Introduction

We are design students from the New School/Parsons conducting an exercise for our research class. The exercise involves a few self-reflective questions, that you may answer out loud or in writing. After we'll ask you a few follow-up questions about how you experienced the exercise.

PART ONE: Guiding Questions

1. Think of a time in your personal practice of day to day life when you felt **uncertain**.
 - i. How did you act?
 - ii. What did you learn?

2. Think of a time in your personal practice of day to day life when you felt **overwhelmed**.
 - i. How did you act?
 - ii. What did you learn?

3. Think of a time in your personal practice of day to day life when you received **help**.
 - i. How did you act?
 - ii. What did you learn?

PART TWO: Insights


1. How did you feel about this activity?
2. How do you feel about the idea of a political candidate going through this in public?
3. How could the format change?

If they ask why are we doing this, ask back! "Why do you think we are doing it?"

PURPOSE

To provide an opportunity for the public to get to know their presidential candidates beyond the aggressive rhetorics of the regular political campaigns and debate formats, thus **THUS BUILDING TRUST AND AUTHENTICITY**.

Create accountability through reflections on past mistakes and learnings. Foster a more thoughtful and reflective political public sphere beyond spectacle and name calling.

There seem to be something very empowering to the participants of being given an opportunity to share their thoughts, but not being asked or pushed to do so.



PROTOTYPE CONCEPT : TV Show format that could either replace or be an addition to the existing presidential debates. Exploration of COLLECTIVE VULNERABILITY

STRUCTURE

- Similar to the debates 1.5 hrs TV show
- Rather than a formal structure, the candidates and other participants would sit around a large round table and talk while enjoying coffee and pastry-dessert.
- Conversation facilitated by HOST - responsible for smooth conversation and that topics of discussion are kept relevant and interesting for broader audience.
- Round table represents a **NON-HIERARCHICAL** structure - equal level of participation
- Conversation would revolve around **3 KEY CONCEPTS** :

High School Civics Class: Learning & Making

NYC Nursing Home: Registration and Presentation



Students study the US political system, learn about current politicians and their policies and research candidates up for election




Students create pamphlets to portray each candidate and summarize their platforms



In pairs, students visit 5 - 10 pre-assigned residents in a NYC nursing home



With each resident, the students guide them through the registration process (if not already registered). Students then give a short presentation about the voting process and timeline, following up with the pamphlets they've made about candidates



Students drop off absentee applications at the nearest borough office



Students deliver absentee applications to the same residents they worked with and residents sign to designate student to pick up and deliver ballot on their behalf. They also present their "preview ballots."



Students research propositions (if applicable) and make a preview ballot, including all candidates up for election along with any propositions that will be on the ballot.



Students go back to nursing home to deliver ballots to elderly residents.



Students drop off ballots at nearest borough office
